### RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO BRIAN MURPHY ARCHITECT, LLC FOR CONCEPTUAL DESIGN TO REHABILITATE THE NOSENZO POND PARK PAVILION

**WHEREAS**, in 2011 the Township acquired the Nosenzo Pond Park (formerly CYO) property for Green Acres Open Space and Recreation; and

**WHEREAS**, to date there have been multiple park improvement projects funded partially by Passaic County Open Space, Farmland and Historic Preservation funds; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a desire to rehabilitate and repurpose the existing underutilized open pavilion; and

**WHEREAS**, a proposal was requested and received from a local architect for the preparation of a conceptual plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for these services to be encumbered from account number 01-270-55-000-001; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Mayor and Township Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute a contract with Brian Murphy Architect, LLC, 179 Cahill Cross Road – Suite 202, West Milford, NJ 07480, for professional architectural services for conceptual design to rehabilitate the Nosenzo Pond Park pavilion in an amount not to exceed \$9,500.00.
2. This contract is awarded as “Professional Services” pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20 et seq. and the Local Public Contracts Law.
3. The total fee authorized for this contract shall not exceed \$9,500.00, without prior written approval of the Township Council.
4. That notice of this action shall be published in accordance with law and said notice to provide that the contract awarded and this resolution authorizing same are available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk.
