



	STATE PUBLIC QUESTION  CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO DEDICATE ASSESSMENTS ON  WAGES BY THE STATE TO THE PAYMENT OF EMPLOYEE BENEFITS  Shall the amendment to Article VIII, Section II of the State Constitution, agreed to by the Legislature, which: prohibits collection by the State of assessments based solely on employee wages and salaries for any purpose other than providing employee benefits; dedicates all employer and employee contributions collected for any employee benefit fund, and all returns on investments of those contributions, to the purpose of that fund; and prohibits any transferring, borrowing, appropriating or using of those contributions or returns for any other purpose, be approved?
Public Questions	INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT  This proposed constitutional amendment prohibits the collection by the State of assessments based on employee wages and salaries for any purpose except paying employee benefits (or making other employee-authorized or federally required payments, in the case of the State's own employees), dedicates all contributions made to the unemployment compensation fund, the State disability benefits fund, or any other employee benefit fund, and all returns on investments of those contributions, to the purpose of that fund, and prohibits the use of those contributions or returns for any other purpose. The requirements of this proposed amendment do not apply to the gross income tax, which is exclusively dedicated by the Constitution to the purpose of reducing or offsetting local property taxes.

# Official 2010 General Election Sample Ballot



### **Instructions for Voting**

To vote for a candidate, press the button □ under the person's name. A green "X" will appear next to your selection.
 To change a selection, press the button □ again. The green "X" will disappear and you may make a new selection.

3 Starting at the left of the face of the machine, press the appropriate number of buttons  $\square$  for each office on the ballot. The machine will not permit you to vote for more than the legal number of candidates for any office.

4 If you wish to cast a write-in vote, go to the PERSONAL CHOICE row and press the button below "Write In" in the same column as the office you wish to write-in. Using the alphabetical keyboard below, enter the name of the person of your choice, one letter at a time. To make a space between the first and middle name or initial and last name, use the arrow pointing to the right on the keyboard. To make a correction, use the arrow pointing to the left. The name you enter will appear in the display to the left of the keyboard. Prior to pressing enter for a write-in vote, be sure you have verified the spelling of the person's name and you have selected the correct office. Your choice is recorded and removed from the display.

WARNING: If instructions for a write-in vote are not followed exactly, then you have an improperly cast write-in vote, which will be void and not counted.

- 5 To vote on a Public Question, press the button □ beneath the word 'YES' or 'NO.' A light will go on.
- 6 After ALL selections have been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON [CAST] located at the bottom right. This electronically records all of your votes.
- 7 Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.
