



WEST MILFORD MUSEUM HANDS-ON HOLIDAY CRAFTS & EXHIBIT

The West Milford Museum is recognizing the holidays with a special seasonal exhibit displaying traditional decorations and activities from earlier periods in history. On Saturdays, beginning on November 24th through December 15th, visitors can discover how local families may have celebrated the holiday season over a century ago. The Museum's Christmas tree will be trimmed with hand-made ornaments, and there are winter themed displays that include antique skis, sled, skates, and quilts, as well as exhibits of the ice cutting industry that was so important to the Township more than a century ago. The Museum also has a unique collection of regional history displays. A Victorian ornament crafting table will be set up for visitors to create their own holiday decoration. The Museum will provide the materials, instructions, and volunteers to assist.
