- 1. Inactive/Pocket Licenses must submit a 12-page Place-to-Place Transfer application with detailed sketch of proposed site and a Police Investigation Request to the Township Clerk's Office and receive satisfactory recommendations from the Health, Fire, Building, Zoning and Police Departments prior to siting/activating this license.
- 2. Prior to activating or re-opening the license, inspections of premises must be made and satisfactory recommendations must be received by the Fire, Health, Building, Zoning and Police Departments.
- 3. Prior to activating or (re)opening the license, Licensee must submit applicable 12 page application pages 1, 2, and 11 of the 12-page ABC application to the Township Clerk's Office with date of activation.
- 4. Health Department Retail Food Establishment license must be acquired with detailed floor plans and satisfactory recommendation received in the Health Office prior to opening.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Clerk will hold the inactive license certificates until these licenses are either activated, sited at a location or transferred.
