- 1) How to take proper position on the court

- 3) Get to the non-volley zone
- 4) Use of the split step
- 5) Introduce dinking straight and diagonal
- 6) When to attack and when not to attack
- 7) How not to get caught in NO MANS LAND
- 8) Time permitting, the drop shot
- 9) Aggressive thinking strategy
